



EXCITING EXPANSION!

The need for expansion of youth space at DFAC is reflected in the continual growth in educational art programming. The original art center building was completed in 1975. 10 years later, sizzling summer visual art camp was created. A little over 10 years later, a half day summer camp, Mini Masters was added. Within a few years, a performing arts camp, Musical Theater, was created. And again within a few years, Art Squad, a teen visual arts camp dealing photography, photoshop, drawing/painting and clay on the wheel, was designed and implemented. In June 2010, Mural Madness adds a fifth summer camp to a well established, consistent, line of art programming excellence. At present, all adult programming is held off site due to all studio spaces being utilized for youth programming (9 art studios, one hands-on museum and one gallery). The original programs accommodated 25 to close to 50 where as now we have a maximum capacity of 180 children weekly. During the school year, four classes for youth were offered up until 2001. At present, youth classes have grown to 10 and an additional 10 for teens. DFAC is also finding that more and more homeschool, public and private schools are in need of additional support in the areas of art. DFAC assists with instructors, studio space, interactive hands on museum with engaging, thoughtful art experiences, and clay facility with wheels and kilns. With this new expansion, DFAC will be able to continue to grow and meet the needs of the community in addition to being able to provide a dedicated children's gallery to display children's art year round.
