# Sizzlin' Summer Visual Art Camp



The visual arts camp exposes students to a variety of media, techniques, art history, and multicultural appreciation in a fun and educational environment. Students will work as a **team** or in **teams of smaller groups** using the **theme of the week**, to work up **sketches**, then **scaled drawings**, then **transferring/enlarging their artwork onto huge sections of paper.**
