#### AWARD GUIDELINES

- Examples of support, including innovative or creative events, programs or materials that reflect the efforts
  of the nominee
- Leadership examples and initiatives within the Dunedin arts community
- Other details regarding the impact and benefits resulting from the nominee's contributions
