# **Sizzlin' Summer** Visual Arts Camp

Ages 6\* -10 \$225 - \$250/week

(\* completion of kindergarten required)



The visual arts camp introduces students to a variety of media, techniques, art history, and multicultural appreciation in a fun and educational environment. Preplanned age appropriate projects, based on the weekly themes are worked on daily and ready to come home by Friday. Clay projects take a few days to be fired and are ready for pick up the following Thursday. Students rotate through four classes a day. Below is a sample schedule: NOTE: Order of classes varies by age group


